Managing Cookies

You can manage your cookie preferences through your browser settings. However, disabling certain cookies may affect the functionality of our website.

The use of Cookies:

Category of Cookies	Description
Necessary Cookies	Necessary cookies are essential for the proper functioning of a website. They enable basic functions like page navigation and access to secure areas.
Performance Cookies	Performance cookies collect information about how visitors use a website, such as which pages are visited most often. This data is aggregated and anonymous.
Functionality Cookies	Functionality cookies enhance the user experience by remembering user preferences, such as language preferences or region selection.
Targeting/Advertising Cookies	Targeting or advertising cookies track user behaviour across websites to deliver more relevant advertisements based on interests and online activities.
Analytical Cookies	Analytical cookies gather information about website usage patterns, allowing for the analysis of user behaviour and the improvement of website performance.
Session Cookies	Session cookies are temporary and are deleted once the user closes their browser. They are crucial for the proper functioning of interactive elements.
Persistent Cookies	Persistent cookies remain on a user's device for a set period, aiding in remembering user preferences and settings for future visits.

How to decline or remove cookies?

To decline or remove cookies, users can typically manage their preferences through their web browser settings. Most browsers allow users to control cookie acceptance, block specific types, or delete existing cookies. Users can access these settings in the browser's privacy or security options.
